



## **Make History!**

**Be the very first artist to be commissioned through the City of Newburgh's Percent for Art Program.**

The City of Newburgh, NY through its Department of Planning and Development and its Arts and Culture Commission are seeking to commission an artist to create original artwork(s) for the City of Newburgh Courthouse at the Broadway School. The Broadway School, which is located at the intersection of Broadway and Robinson Avenue, will be converted into the Newburgh Courthouse. To accommodate this transition, a new addition is being attached to the north side of the existing building and will serve as the building's main entrance and lobby. All of the artwork sites are located within the Courthouse lobby. These sites take the form of ten (10) window openings which will be covered and provide a smooth, continuous surface for the artwork.

The maximum budget for all the artwork is \$75,000.00, (\$7,500.00 per panel). Out of the final budget, the artist will receive a design fee of up to 20% of the total artwork budget. As part of this fee, the artist will be required to produce a final design as well as oversee the fabrication and installation of the completed artwork in the courthouse.

The artwork will be selected through a blind selection process. Panelists will not know the names or addresses of the artists being considered. The artwork will be selected solely on the merits and appropriateness of the proposal. One artist will be selected for this project.



### **PROJECT ORIENTATION**

A workshop will be held to assist artists who need help in the preparation of their submission materials. Artists are NOT required to attend this workshop in order to submit for this project.
