

**City of Newburgh  
Public Hearing Notice**

On May 22, 2006, the City of Newburgh will hold a public hearing at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 83 Broadway, Newburgh, NY. The purpose of this hearing will be to offer the citizens an opportunity to comment on the City's proposed actions for the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for Fiscal Year 2006. The primary objectives of the CDBG program are: to provide decent housing, provide a suitable living environment and to expand economic opportunities. The City of Newburgh has prepared a Consolidated Plan for the period between Fiscal Years 2004-2009. A copy of this plan is available at the location listed below. The 2006 Action Plan is consistent with the Five-Year Consolidated Plan.

**Action Plan**

The plan contains the City's Action Plan for its Community Development Funds (Fiscal Year 2006). The proposed Action Plan is as follows:
