What is an LWRP/HMP?

One of the ways a community can take full advantage of their waterfront is by using New York State's Local Waterfront Revitalization Program (LWRP). An LWRP is both a plan and a program. As a planning document, an LWRP is a locally prepared, land and water use plan and strategy for a community's natural, public, working, and/or developed waterfront through which critical issues are addressed. In partnership with the New York State Division of Coastal Resources, the City of Newburgh is in the process of preparing amendments to its 2002 LWRP as well as a Harbor Management Plan (HMP). This workshop is intended to help inform the community and build community consensus regarding the future of the LWRP and HMP areas.
