Due to a reduction in funding from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development to CDBG entitlement communities, the City of Newburgh was required to amend the approved 2011 annual plan and budget. On June 18, 2011 the City Council approved the following amended activities and budget for the City's 2011 Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Program. The public has an opportunity to comment in writing until July 20, 2011 on the amended budget. The amendments eliminated the Housing Counseling services program and A Brush with Kindness program. The amendment also reduces funding for scattered sidewalk and street improvement project and increases funding for demolition and youth services.
