The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program is the principal Federal program providing grants to communities to create innovative approaches to improve physical, economic and social conditions. The City of Newburgh CDBG strategy is directed toward the needs of low and moderate income residents in the City of Newburgh.

A CDBG Advisory Committee has been established to assist in the assessment of projects presented for funding consideration on an annual basis. Appointed by the City Council, this six member committee includes three (3) members of the community and three (3) professional practitioners selected on the basis of their knowledge, interest, and experience in dealing with issues relating to housing, the homeless, the disabled, youth and senior services, and social services.
