City of Newburgh Issues Request for Proposals For Community Development Block Grant Funding for Youth Programs

The City of Newburgh has identified youth services as a priority and has designated a portion of the fiscal year 2011 and 2012 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to be utilized as grants to non-profit organizations serving City of Newburgh youth. A Request for Proposals (RFP) has been issued so eligible service providers can apply for CDBG funding for youth programs.

In order to receive funding, all applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- Address Youth Violence Prevention or Workforce Development/ Entrepreneurial Development
- Lead applicant must be a non-profit organization with 501 (C) (3) tax exempt designation
- The program requesting funding must serve low income youth (under age 21) who are residents of the City of Newburgh

Technical assistance will be provided to those interested organizations on January 30, 2012 at 5 p.m. at City Hall, 83 Broadway, in the 3rd floor City Council Chambers.
