288-17b **Overweight Vehicles**

All trucks, tractors and tractor-trailer combinations having a total gross weight of more than 5 tons are excluded from all city streets except on these streets:

1. Broadway from city line west to Robinson.
2. Lake Street from city line south to Broadway.
3. Robinson Ave. from city line north to city line south.
4. South Street from city line west to Robinson Ave.

The following three exceptions are also allowed:

1. The pickup or delivery of merchandise or other property on streets that would be normally excluded, provided that the most direct route to and from the nearest truck route is used.
2. The operation of an overweight vehicle as part of a driver's test lawfully conducted by the NYS DMV.
3. The operation of an overweight vehicle while driving it to a test site for a NYS DMV road test provided the most direct route to and from the nearest truck route is used.

Violations Involving Dogs

- 150-11-C Keeping of more than five (5) cats
- 150-15-1 Dog at large (no leash or collar)
- 150-15-2 Barking Dog (with a neighbors complaint)
- 150-15-3 Dog causes damage to the property of another.
- 150-16 Fecal matter on the property of another by an at large dog with an owner.
- 150-17 Vicious Dog: Allowing a dog with vicious propensities to go at large at any time within the City. The owner must post "WARNING, DANGEROUS DOG"
- 150-21-1 Unsupervised Dog. Dog outdoors: tied, fenced or confined without someone on the premises.
- 150-21-2B Dog Kennels.
 1. No kennels shall be in the front or side yard of any building.
 2. No kennels shall be on the premises of any two or more family dwelling except with the permission of the owner.

Pit Bulls

- 150-25 Whenever outside of closed premises a pit-bull shall be restrained by an adequate collar, leash and SHALL HAVE A MUZZLE securely fixed to the animals mouth. AND the person with the dog outside of closed premises shall carry with him or her an implement capable of forcing open the animals jaws.
- 150-27 "WARNING: DANGEROUS DOG" must be posted at each entrance to the premises by the owner of the premises on which a pit bull is kept, maintained or housed.

Notes

- Any violations of the sections above are to be considered violation arrests. Appearance tickets are to be issued in most cases.
- For any dog owner guilty of a second or subsequent violation of any provision of this article: in addition to any other penalties that may be impose, the animal in question may be confiscated and later destroyed.
