### **City Officials Addressing Parking Issues During St. Luke's Construction**

With construction underway for the new St. Luke's Hospital Parking Facility, the City of Newburgh is taking steps to address parking issues for neighborhood residents.

During construction, which could take up to 18 months, the City has designated parking on Dubois St. for resident parking only. Last week, City officials met with Dubois St. residents and issued around 60 parking permits.

If you are a Dubois Street resident and did not receive a parking permit, you may still obtain one at the City of Newburgh Codes Compliance Office, 123 Grand Street (old Grand Street courthouse), during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m.- 4 p.m. You must provide identification, proof of residency (utility bill, tax bill, etc.), driver's license, and vehicle registration information. Call 569-7400 for more information.

Parking spaces for employees are available in the Ann Street Parking Lot, with shuttle service provided every half hour. Hospital visitors will utilize valet parking services provided by the hospital.

“During this time, our goal is to ensure that neighborhood residents have adequate parking,” City Manager Jean-Ann McGrane noted. “We will continue to work closely with hospital administration to minimize any inconvenience and to address any issues that may arise. We appreciate the cooperation and patience of employees and residents and we look forward to the benefits of this state-of-the-art parking facility.”
