Brown's Pond to Re-Open for Fishing Saturday

Brown's Pond, one of the area's prime fishing spots, will re-open at 6 a.m. on Saturday, June 16. The pond, closed to the public since the 9/11 terrorist attacks, will be open seven days a week 6 a.m. to 6 pm.

Brown's Pond is stocked with trout, bass and pickerel, and reputedly offers some of the best fishing around.

The charges are as follows:

- **City residents:** One person & boat- \$6 a day; two people & boat- \$10 a day; three people & boat- \$14 a day.
- **Non-city residents:** One person & boat- \$10 a day; two people & boat- \$18 a day; Three people & boat- \$26 a day.
- **Senior Citizens:** Half-price on Mondays (Must be 60 years of age & older- proof of age is required.)

Access to Brown's Pond is off Mt. Airy Road. No outside boats are allowed, and there is no fishing from the shore. Boat rentals are available. Fishing is also allowed at Masterson Park.
