“Spring & Summer” Art Exhibit By Jacquelyn J. Pruikisma in City Hall

From now until September 3, visitors to City Hall at 83 Broadway can experience the beauty of “Spring & Summer,” an exhibit of oil paintings by Jacquelyn J. Pruikisma.

Inspired by the painting of Velasquez, Rembrandt, and the French and American Impressionists, Ms. Pruikisma is dedicated to the study of the principles of light as it illuminates the earth.

A resident of the Town of Warwick, Jacquelyn’s paintings have been exhibited throughout the Northeast. Venues include Hudson Valley Art Association, National Arts Club, American Artists Professional League, Salmagundi Club, Catharine Lorillard Wolfe Art Club, Ridgewood Art Institute, Allied Artists of America, Audubon Artists, Visual Arts Alliance of Long Island, and Hackensack Meadowlands Commission.

Her awards include first prizes from the American Artists Professional League, the Ann Waldron Award, the Kent Art Association Award and the Clem and James Weber Marine Award from the Ridgewood Art Institute. Ms. Pruikisma holds degrees from William Paterson University and Columbia University. She has taught art professionally throughout her career in public and private school settings.
