Paintings by Frances Biancardi in Downing Park Visitors Center for November



The November exhibit at the Visitors Center in Downing Park will feature the paintings of Milton artist Frances Biancardi. Biancardi works primarily in oils and has been painting since she retired in 1992. The exhibit will include recent work done in the Hudson Valley and in Vero Beach, Florida where the artist spends her winters and is a member of the Vero Beach Art Club and Museum. Locally, she is a member of the Society of Decorative Painters and the Hudson Valley Tole and Decorative Painters.

Biancardi studied oil painting at Mount St. Mary College with Carol Galietta, and has exhibited locally and in Florida. She paints a variety of subjects but all her work reflects her fascination with light and color and a serene personal vision.
