Through the month of April, visitors to City Hall can enjoy beautiful Hudson Valley paintings by Montgomery illustrator and artist, Mike Jaroszko.

A reception for the artist will be held on Friday, April 17 from 2-4 p.m. in the lobby of City Hall. All are welcome to attend.

After 20 years of illustrating books and magazines, and many awards, Mike Jaroszko is now venturing out into the world of fine art. His paintings of the Hudson Valley celebrate the people and their livelihoods, from the past to the present, capturing the fun of horse riding on a farm to riding the waves of the Hudson River in a schooner. Most recently, his works were on display in the Newburgh Free Library.

Mike was born in Canada and studied art in England at the Canterbury College of Art. He now resides in Montgomery, working as an illustrator. He has been commissioned by companies such as Bradford Exchange, Reader's Digest, Avon, Scholastic Books, Smithsonian, Cricket magazine, Leapfrog and many others.
