City of Newburgh Seeks City Residents For Fiscal Advisory Board

On November 16, 2009, the City Council of the City of Newburgh established a Fiscal Advisory Board to ensure internal controls over the receipt and disbursement of public funds. Applications are being sought from City residents for three seats on this board which will also include the City Manager as chairperson, one City Council person, the Comptroller, and the Corporation Counsel. There is no compensation for serving on this board, to be appointed by Council at a January meeting.

The responsibilities of the Fiscal Advisory Board will include reviewing the receipt of public funds and the disbursement of funds proposed by the Comptroller, no less than every 10 business days. The Board will report on this review to Council at least every 30 business days. They will also encourage the Comptroller to install systems and methods to improve internal controls.

Candidates should forward a resume and a letter of interest to Acting City Manager Richard F. Herbek, 83 Broadway, City Hall, Newburgh, N.Y. 12550. The deadline for applications is December 30, 2009.
