From now until Jan. 31, visitors to City Hall can enjoy local photographs by Newburgh native Emily Hunter in the City Hall lobby. A reception for her will be held on Monday, January 26 from 2-4 p.m. in City Hall, 83 Broadway.

Emily, a 25 year old free-lance photographer, is “a born and bred product of Newburgh, N.Y.” She first took photography classes while attending Newburgh Free Academy, and later furthered her art education while earning a Bachelor’s Degree in History at the College of Mount Saint Vincent in Riverdale, NY.

Her photographer’s eye “is most often drawn to capturing the dichotomy of the era in which we live: the essence of a landscape all too often stained with brutality, yet in which the energies of humanity, beauty, and love still thrive and radiate,” she said.

The subjects of her photographs vary from people to urban streetscapes to natural landscapes. The exhibit in City Hall includes unique perspectives of familiar Newburgh landmarks such as Broadway, Downing Park, and Washington’s Headquarters, captured in beautiful color or black and white.
