### Orange County Rural Development Advisory Corp. Will Present Weatherization Program at Citizen Advisory Committee Meeting March 25

Orange County Rural Development Advisory Corp. (RDAC) will present an introduction to their Weatherization Program at the March 25 Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting. This program was rescheduled from February 25 due to the snowstorm. CAC meetings are held at 7 p.m. on the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month at the City of Newburgh Activity Center, 401 Washington Street. All are welcome to attend. .

The weatherization program has four steps including an application to determine program eligibility, an energy audit to identify needs, weatherization of the home, and inspection of completed work to assure quality.

Services might include but are not limited to:

- air sealing of cracks and holes to reduce heat loss,
- insulation of attics and walls,
- heating system repairs or replacement,
- providing efficient lighting and refrigeration,
- window and/or outside door repair or replacement
