NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In order to prepare its 2010 Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan, the City of Newburgh City Council will hold a public hearing on August 10, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, 83 Broadway, Newburgh, NY.

The purpose of this public hearing will be to obtain citizens' views on the City's housing and community development needs, including priority non-housing community development needs.

In addition, the City of Newburgh will also be drafting its Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan for 2010 – 2014. The Consolidated Plan is intended to be a 3-5 year strategic plan that brings needs and resources together in a coordinated housing and community development strategy. This strategy must be developed to achieve the following statutory goals, principally for low, very low-, and extremely low-income residents:

- provide decent housing
- create suitable living environments, and
- expand economic opportunities

This strategic plan guides the City's utilization of various public and private resources, especially the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Community Planning and Development (CPD) formula programs. These CPD programs include the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

The public hearing will solicit comments on both the FY 2010 Action Plan and the Five Year Consolidated Plan.

Each year the City formulates an action plan for one-year use of funds aimed at implementing the strategies of the Consolidated Plan. The City of Newburgh anticipates receiving a CDBG entitlement allocation of approximately \$830,000 for Fiscal Year 2010 which will be included in this year's action plan.
