

WASHINGTON LAKE BOAT RENTALS AND RULES

Daily Permits

CITY Residents - \$6

NON-CITY Resident - \$10

Extra Passenger (city-resident) - \$4

Extra Passenger (non-city res.) - \$8

One person & a boat

City resident - \$6

Non-city resident - \$10

Two people in a boat

City residents - \$10

Non-city residents - \$18

Three people in a boat

City residents - \$14

Non-city residents-\$26

**** Senior Citizens – 60 years of age & older are half price on Monday (proof of age is required).**

**** Proof of residence is required to verify fees.**

Rules

- Hours – 6:00am to 6:00pm daily; closed on holidays.
- All fishing permits must be completed in full. Proof of residency is required at all times to obtain a daily permit. The City reserves the right to inspect all packages and containers that will be taken into a boat. This is to ensure that there will not be any contaminants going on to the lake that will pollute the City's water supply. The fishing attendant has the right to inspect and check all packages and containers. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in a permit not being issued to fish.
- No boat rentals after 4pm.
- Boats must be moored prior to 5:30pm.
- Alcoholic beverages or intoxicating substances are not allowed.
- No fishing from shore.
- Boats are not to be moored to the shore.
- Boats are to be operated in a safe and correct manner at the direction of the fishing attendant.
- No swimming is allowed.
- Each and every person occupying the boat must wear at all times an approved life preserver or life jacket.
- The City of Newburgh and the fishing attendants have the right to call in all boats in bad weather conditions.
- Please return oars and life jackets to the trailer when finished fishing.
- No one under the age of seven years old is allowed in the boat.
- Electric motors ARE allowed to be used.
- Fish limits:

<u>Species</u>	<u>Minimum Length</u>	<u>Daily Limit</u>
Trout	10"	5 per person
Bass	12"	5 per person
Pickeral	15"	5 per person
Panfish	Any size	10 per person

*****Fishing attendants have the right to inspect and check all fish*****
