The goal of this event is to bring the City of Newburgh, Town of Newburgh, Town of New Windsor, as well as local, state and federal agencies together to discuss roles and responsibilities in response to an incident involving contamination of the City of Newburgh's water supply reservoirs. This event will provide an opportunity to discuss response plans and identify gaps and shortcomings before an incident occurs.

The TTX will be based on a hypothetical scenario designed to bring together the water sector, public safety, county and state agencies to discuss roles and responsibilities during a drinking water emergency.
