**Calls for Service** 2,585 calls for service

**172 Broadway** (Area of Kennedy Chicken)

A patrol plan has been put into place to create a high visibility enforcement of all criminal and quality of life violations in the area in front of 160 to 190 Broadway. There have been 2,383 arrests within this targeted area from January 1, 1996 to present. 1 arrests were documented during this report period. 33 total arrests have been acknowledged YTD 2012.

**Prostitution Enforcement** (Citywide) Prostitution related offenses have in the past been the source of several complaints. This department will continue to take citywide action to arrest those involved. During the period of this report there were 5 prostitution arrests affected with 11 arrests YTD 2012 and 1,164 total prostitution related arrests since Jan. 1, 1998.

**Alarm Systems in the City of Newburgh Chapter 103 Newburgh City Code** 135 **false** alarms were responded to during this (June) month by the police department. 677 false alarms have been responded to by police in 2012.



**Part One Crime Activity: January 1 through June 17, 2012**

**Part One crime**

The Federal Bureau of Investigations designates Part One crimes or Index crimes as Murder, Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Larceny and Auto Theft. Murder, Rape, Robbery and Aggravated Assault form the Violent Crime category, while Burglary, Larceny and Motor Vehicle Theft constitute the Property Crime category. The City of Newburgh Police reports totals for all Part One crimes monthly to the New York State Department of Criminal Justice Services.

Year to date there have been 768 Part One crimes in the City of Newburgh (Table 1). The City is experiencing increases in multiple crime categories. Fortunately, the City is experiencing a reduction in two extremely problematic Violent Crimes: Homicide (-67%) and Robbery (-10%).

**Recent Activity**

May 2012 was a difficult month for the City of Newburgh with increases in several Part One crimes (Table 2). The City has been struggling this year with increases in Aggravated Assaults after a prolonged period of reductions. June is showing the first decreases in Aggravated Assaults in months (Table 3). Residential Burglaries have also been problematic so far this year, but May 2012 showed some decreases after several arrests. Unfortunately, the City's high volume of Violent Crime absorbs much of the investigative abilities of the Police Department leaving less resources to focus on Burglaries. June so far is showing a significant increase in Residential Burglaries, while Commercial Burglaries have decreased.

The last 28 days of data shows positive information. The City analyzes data in 28 day increment account for about a month's worth of activity with an equal number of weekends. The City of Newburgh see increased violence during the weekends, so when comparing data by time, an equal number of week days is critical. The most recent 28 day period (May 21 - June 17) is showing a reduction in multiple categories compared to the previous 28 days (April 23 - May 20). Total Part One crime decreased by 15 including reductions in Violent Crime (-23%) and Property Crime (-12%). While Robberies showed an increase, Aggravated Assaults have decreased by 48% for the time period. Three of the four Property Cr showed double digit reductions.


**Current Issues**

Residential Burglaries are of great concern to the City of Newburgh Police given the lack of resources to sufficiently investigate them and the fear of violation of a home instills in City residents. Several recent Residential Burglaries show unlocked doors or windows, giving criminals easy access inside homes. Burglars are mostly targeting electronics in current incidents. Analysis is showing increased activity in the southeast quadrant of the City within a few blocks of Renwick St and S Clark St. Additionally, the department has reported an increase in Residential Burglary activity within a few block area of South St and Prospect St.

The City is also seeing a series of Thefts from Motor Vehicles in the southeast quadrant of the City. This activity is more dispersed throughout the southeast quadrant with a tighter concentration of activity around the few block area of S Lander St and Benkard Ave. Reports are showing mostly overnight thefts with force used to break windows when necessary to gain access inside vehicles. Small electronics like Ipods and GPS units are frequently targeted in these types of thefts.
