

# Directions to the City of Newburgh Annual Labor-Day Weekend International Waterfront Festival

*Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd/ Water St.*

The City of Newburgh is located on the Hudson River, 60 miles north of New York City. The city lies at the intersection of Interstate 84 (running west to Pennsylvania and east to Connecticut) and the New York State Thruway (I-87), which runs from New York City north to Albany.

#### **From NY State Thruway**


From New York State Thruway I-87 exit 17-Newburgh to 17K, take a left onto 17 (17K becomes Broadway in the City of Newburgh) Follow it all the way to the end, turn left on Colden Street.

#### **From I-84**

If you're traveling to the festival from I-84 Exit 10S. Take 9W South (Robinson Avenue) to Broadway. Turn left on Broadway, then left on Colden Street.

#### **From West**

If you're traveling to the festival from the west take 9W (Robinson Avenue). Take a right on Broadway and follow left onto Colden Street. Street parking is available near the festival location.

Parking is available at the Second Street Parking Lot (by Newburgh Free Library 124 Grand Street), the Ann Street Parking Lot (on Ann Street, just off Broadway), the parking lot at Broadway and Grand St., across from City Hall, Chambers Street Parking Lot (Behind the Department of Motor Vehicles, at Broadway and Chambers Street), and the Ferry Parking Lot on Front Street. Handicapped parking is available at the City Lot on Martin Luther King Boulevard at Fourth Street.
