City of Newburgh, NY Newburgh celebrates the Arts! **60 artists will participate** in the **Fifth Annual Newburgh Open Studios**. Newburgh Open Studios 2015 will be the 5th annual studio tour taking place on Saturday and Sunday, September 26th and 27th, 2015 from 11am - 5pm each day. It is a Free self-guided tour. Maps will be available at Newburgh Art Supply, 5 Grand Street, Saturday and Sunday September 26th and 27th starting at 10am.

Organized by Gerardo Castro and Michael Gabor, co-owners of Newburgh Art Supply, this year's Newburgh Open Studios will introduce the public to Newburgh's burgeoning arts community with the opening of artists' work studios, alternative gallery spaces, store front windows, and a very special launch event showcasing artist Ruedi Hofmann.

Newburgh Open Studios features a diverse selection of styles and artistic disciplines, from avant-garde video and sculpture to bookbinding, performance art, and traditional oil painting. Visitors will have the unique opportunity to meet and talk with emerging and established artists and craftspeople in spaces rarely open to the public. Much of the self-guided tour is 'walkable' and includes Atlas Industries, The Foundry, Ann Street Studios, Newburgh Mercantile, Thornwillow Institute, Yellowbird Gallery, Space Create, GlenLily Manor as well as home studios in the Historic District.

Part of the Newburgh Open Studios will also be **GlenLily Grounds 2015**, organized by Lacey Fekishazy: 14 artists participate in an exhibition of outdoor site-specific art and sculpture, part of Newburgh Open Studios 2015 days and times of tour and will be spread out, on the GlenLily Manor estate, over 11 acres of field, hill, and wood. GlenLily Manor, 532 Grand Avenue, is in the hamlet of Balmville on the west bank of the Hudson River.
