

**City of Newburgh
Public Hearing Notice**

On November 12, 2013, the City of Newburgh will hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 83 Broadway, Newburgh, NY. The purpose of this hearing will be to offer the citizens an opportunity to comment on the City's proposed actions for the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for Fiscal Year 2014. The primary objectives of the CDBG program are: to provide decent housing, provide a suitable living environment and to expand economic opportunities. The City of Newburgh has prepared a Consolidated Plan for the period between Fiscal Years 2010-2015. A copy of this plan is available at the location listed below. The 2014 Action Plan is consistent with the Five-Year Consolidated Plan.
