**Calls for Service** 2642 calls for service  
YTD 19,653 calls citywide.  
(Average 86 calls per day, or 29 calls per 8 hr shift, seven days per week)

**Vehicle and Traffic Enforcement** 280 traffic tickets issued during this time period. YTD 1677 traffic tickets issued citywide.  
(Average 8 traffic tickets per day, seven days per week)

**Parking Tickets** August 1235 total tickets MTD 11,522 total tickets YTD

An average of 55 parking tickets were written per day, seven days per week.

**Vehicle Accidents** 107 reported and investigated YTD 916  
(Average / 4 accidents investigated per day, seven days per week.)

**172 Broadway** (Area of Kennedy Chicken)  
A patrol plan has been put into place to create a high visibility enforcement of all criminal and quality of life violations in the area in front of 160 to 190 Broadway. There have been 2,496 arrests within this targeted area from January 1, 1996 to present. 16 arrests were documented during this report period. 90 total arrests have been acknowledged YTD 2013.

**Dubois Street** (between Broadway and Third Street) 7 arrests during this period. 45 arrests have been effected YTD 2013. Officers have effected 1,147 arrests in this area since June 8, 1998.

**South Street** (between Grand Street and North Miller) Officers have effected: 3 arrests during this period, with 19 arrests YTD 2013. With their emphasis on visibility, officers have effected: 976 total arrests in this targeted area since June 6, 1998.

**Johnston Street** (entire length) Patrol plan with emphasis on disorderly conduct, narcotics violations, loud music, and illegal loitering. There was 2 arrests during the period of this report with 25 arrests YTD 2013. Officers have effected 1,586 arrests in this targeted area since January 1, 2002.

**South Lander Street** (entire length) Patrol plan with emphasis on illegal loitering, narcotics violations, disorderly conduct and loud music. There were 2 arrests during the period of this report with 11 arrests YTD 2013. Officers have effected 266 arrests in this targeted area since January 1, 2002.

**Chamber Street** (entire length) Patrol plan with emphasis on narcotics violations, illegal loitering, disorderly conduct and loud music. There were 6 arrests during the period of this report with 35 arrests YTD 2013. Officers have effected 865 arrests in this targeted area since January 1, 2002.

**Lander Street** (entire length) Patrol plan with emphasis on narcotics violations, illegal loitering, disorderly conduct and loud music. There were 5 arrests during the period of this report with 40 arrests YTD 2013. Officers have effected 1,199 arrests in this targeted area since January 1, 2002.

**Renwick Street** (entire length) Patrol plan with emphasis on narcotics violations, illegal loitering, disorderly conduct and loud music. There were 5 arrests during the period of this report with 41 arrests YTD 2013. Officers have effected 711 arrests in this targeted area since January 1, 2002.

**Benkard Ave** (entire length) Patrol plan with emphasis on narcotics violations, illegal loitering, disorderly conduct, and loud music. There were 11 arrests during the period of this report with 31 arrests YTD 2013. Officers have effected 483 arrests in this targeted area since January 1, 2002.

**Liberty Street Flats** Patrol Plan with emphasis on narcotics and prostitution violations, open container, loud music and disorderly conduct. There were 5 arrests during the time of this report and 51 arrests since January 1, 2013. Officers have made 635 arrests in the area of the Liberty Street Flats since Jan. 1, 2004.

**William Street** (between Broadway and Renwick Street) With a strong emphasis on visibility and quality of life, officers effected: 27 arrests during this period, with 85 arrests YTD 2013. 2,483 total arrests were effected in this targeted area since September 1, 1998.

**Prostitution Enforcement** (Citywide) Prostitution related offenses have in the past been the source of several complaints. This department will continue to take citywide action to arrest those involved. During the period of this report there were 0 prostitution arrests affected with 30 arrests YTD 2013 and 1,201 total prostitution related arrests since Jan. 1, 1998.

**The City of Newburgh Police participate in  
Orange County STOP DWI**

STOP-DWI stands for "Special Traffic Options Program for Driving While Intoxicated". The STOP-DWI program was enacted by the State Legislature in 1981 for the purpose of empowering and coordinating local efforts to reduce alcohol and other drug-related traffic crashes within the context of a comprehensive and financially self-sustaining statewide alcohol and highway safety program. The STOP-DWI legislation permits each of the state's 62 counties to establish a county STOP-DWI Program which qualifies the county for the return of all fines collected for alcohol and other drug-related traffic offenses occurring in its jurisdiction.

All 62 counties have opted to participate. Each county appoints a STOP-DWI Coordinator, whose duties include the development of a program and the coordination of efforts by agencies involved in alcohol and highway safety.

**STOP DWI Grants applied for and received**

**Summer 2010 75 hrs, \$3,675.00**

75 hours were used to make 12 patrol shifts. Officers made (57) traffic stops, (7) DWI arrests, (12) 1192 tickets were written, (3) suspended license arrests were made and (62) other violations were issued.

**Fall 2010 70 hrs, \$3,387.00**

70 hours were used to make 10 patrol shifts. Officers made (44) traffic stops, (7) DWI arrests, (10) 1192 tickets were written, (1) suspended license arrests were made and (39) other violations were issued.

**Spring 2011 70 hrs, \$3,452.00**

70 hours were used to make 11 patrol shifts. Officers made (61) traffic stops, (4) DWI arrests, (7) 1192 tickets were written, (1) suspended license arrests were made and (53) other violations were issued.

**Summer 2011 70 hrs, \$3,287.00**

65 hours were used to make 11 patrol shifts. Officers made (75) traffic stops, (3) DWI arrests, (6) 1192 tickets were written, (3) suspended license arrests were made and (68) other violations were issued.

**Fall 2011 60 hrs, \$2,828.00**

65 hours were used to make 9 patrol shifts. Officers made (53) traffic stops, (1) DWI arrests, (2) 1192 tickets were written, (2) suspended license arrests were made and (35) other violations were issued.

**Spring 2012 70 hrs, \$3,465.00**

70 hours were used to make 12 patrol shifts. Officers made (67) traffic stops, (3) DWI arrests, (4) 1192 tickets were written, (1) suspended license arrests were made and (43) other violations were issued.

**Summer 2012 75 hrs, \$3,522.00**

75 hours were used to make 11 patrol shifts. Officers made (54) traffic stops, (4) DWI arrests, (8) 1192 tickets were written, (2) suspended license arrests were made and (46) other violations were issued.

**Fall 2012 60 hrs, \$2,818.00**

60 hours were used to make 9 patrol shifts. Officers made (42) traffic stops, (0) DWI arrests, (0) 1192 tickets were written, (1) suspended license arrests was made and (24) other violations were issued.

**Spring 2013 40 hrs, \$1,935.00**

40 hours were used to make 7 patrol shifts. Officers made (32) traffic stops, (0) DWI arrests, (0) 1192 tickets were written, (2) suspended license arrests was made and (29) other violations were issued.

**Summer 2013 70 hrs, \$3,287.00**

69 hours were used to make 11 patrol shifts. Officers made (54) traffic stops, (1) DWI arrest, (2) 1192 tickets were written, (4) suspended license arrests was made and (52) other violations were issued.







## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

### **Issue Date: August 8, 2013**

**NEW YORK CITY CRIME WAS DOWN (-2%).** Through July 28, 2013, NYPD reported decreases in murder (-27.5%), robbery (-9%), burglary (-8%) and grand larceny auto (-11%). Increases were reported in rape (+2%), felony assault (+2%) and grand larceny (+5%).

**NON-NEW YORK CITY CRIME WAS DOWN (-10%) IN THE FIRST FIVE MONTHS OF 2013.** Violent crime was down (-9%) and property crime was down (-10.5%) for the first five months of 2013.

**IN THE 17 IMPACT SITES CRIME WAS DOWN (-8%) FOR THE FIRST HALF OF 2013.** Violent crime was down (-7%) and property crime was down (-8%) in the first half of 2013. Compared to the five year average (2008-2012), year-to-date Index crime was down (-10%), with violent crime down (-8%) and property crime down (-11%).

**VIOLENT CRIME WAS UP MORE THAN 5% IN THREE IMPACT SITES.** These sites were: Binghamton (+10%), Jamestown (+6%) and Kingston (+22%).

**IMPACT JURISDICTIONS REPORTED 83 MURDERS SO FAR THIS YEAR, WITH 16 REPORTED IN JUNE.** Murder was up (+20%) through June. This was largely driven by seven jurisdictions. These jurisdictions reported the following number of homicides from January – June 2013, as compared to January – June 2012: Albany (3 vs. 1), Nassau County (6 vs. 3), Newburgh (5 vs. 1), Niagara Falls (2 vs. 0), Poughkeepsie (2 vs. 0), Syracuse (12 vs. 5) and Utica (3 vs. 0).

**ROBBERY WAS UP 15% OR MORE IN THREE IMPACT SITES.** These sites were: Binghamton (+72%), Kingston (+18%) and Rochester (+16%).

**FIREARM-RELATED VIOLENT CRIMES WERE DOWN (-3%) SO FAR THIS YEAR.** There were 1,610 firearm-related violent crimes reported in the first half of 2013 as compared to 1,662 in the first half of 2012.

**IMPACT SITES REPORTED 308 SHOOTING INCIDENTS INVOLVING INJURY, DOWN (-5.5%) COMPARED TO THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR.** Although overall incidents were down, the following six jurisdictions experienced an increase in shootings during the first six months of 2013, as compared to the first six months of 2012: Newburgh (16 vs. 12), Niagara Falls (12 vs. 9), Poughkeepsie (17 vs. 5), Rochester (94 vs. 80), Suffolk (25 vs. 15), and Utica (9 vs. 2). Shooting fatalities were also up from 43 in 2012 to 54 in 2013.

**STATEWIDE FELONY ARRESTS WERE DOWN (-2%).** Felony drug arrests were down (-2%), violent felony arrests were down (-3%) and misdemeanor arrests were down (-8%).

**PAROLEE AND PROBATIONER ARRESTS WERE DOWN.** Parolee arrests were down (-2%) and probationer arrests were down (-6%).
