Part One Crime = 16

Part One crime during the week of January 18th through January 24th showed a decrease compared to the previous week. Total Violent Crime figures experienced no change for the week. Both Rape and Robbery revealed decreases compared to the previous week. Aggravated Assaults yielded an increase for the week. There was one domestic Aggravated Assault and one gun related Aggravated Assault. There were no bullet to body shootings during the week. Property Crime experienced a decrease for the week compared to the previous week. Half the Property Crime subcategories showed reductions.

City of Newburgh Police did not administer Narcan during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 422

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 422 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of 16% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Alarm" with 12% of the call activity for the week. This call type showed an increase of five additional entries compared to the previous week. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 10% of entries. This call type showed a 24% reduction for the week.

Weapon related calls for service increased this week compared to the previous week. While "Shots Fired" entries showed a significant reduction, it was not enough to offset the weekly increase sustained by "Gun Call" entries. The other two call types remained unchanged.

Written Incident Reports = 80

Arrests = 37

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 37 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Grand Larceny 4th, Assault 2nd, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 2nd, Criminal Contempt 2nd, Petit Larceny, Attempted Gang Assault 2nd, Obstruction of Breathing/Blood, Criminal Trespass 3rd and Menacing 2nd. Officers arrested eleven people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 30% of the arrests for the week.
