Part One Crime = 26

Part One crime during the week of November 23rd through November 29th revealed an increase in total Part One crime numbers compared to the previous week. Total Violent Crime figures remained unchanged after Robbery increased by one incident and Aggravated Assault decreased by one incident. There was one domestic Assault during the week. There were six gun related Assaults with five bullet to body shootings. These incidents are currently under investigation. Property Crime yielded an increase for the week compared to the previous week. Both Residential Burglary and Larceny saw increases during the week.

City of Newburgh Police did not administer Narcan during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 480

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 480 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of 24% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Alarm" with 9% of the call activity for the week. This call type showed similar volume compared to the previous week. "Traffic Complaint" was the next most frequent call type with 8% of entries. This call type decreased by approximately 49% this week compared to the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service showed a reduction this week compared to the previous week, but it is still high. "Shots Fired" entries showed the only increase for the week. "Gun Call" and "Shooting" entries had decreases this week compared to the previous week. "Weapon Violation" entries showed no change.

Arrests = 40

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 40 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Criminal Mischief 3rd, Obstruction of Breathing/Blood, Assault 3rd, Aggravated Harassment 2nd, Criminal Contempt 1st, Menacing 2nd, Grand Larceny 4th, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7th, Petit Larceny and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. Officers arrested fourteen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 35% of the arrests for the week.
