## Part One Crime = 14

Part One crime during the week of November 30th through December 6th experienced a significant reduction in total Part One crime numbers compared to the previous week. Total Violent Crime figures showed the highest decrease after reductions in Aggravated Assault. There were no domestic Assaults during the week. There were no gun related Assaults or Robberies during the week. Property Crime yielded a decrease for the week compared to the previous week. Reductions occurred in three of the four Property Crime subcategories.

*City of Newburgh Police did not administer Narcan during the reporting period.*

## Calls for Service = 459

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 459 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of 4% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Disorderly Person" with 10% of the call activity for the week. This call type increased by 28.5% this week compared to the previous week. "Traffic Complaint" was the next most frequent call type with 7% of entries. This call type decreased by approximately 18% this week compared to the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service showed a significant reduction this week compared to the previous week. "Shots Fired" and "Gun Call" entries both decreased by two-thirds. "Shooting" entries decrease this week as well compared to the previous week. "Weapon Violation" entries showed no change.

## Written Incident Reports = 79

## Arrests = 47

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 47 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Petit Larceny, Aggravated Harassment 2nd, Criminal Contempt 2nd, Obstruction of Breathing/Blood Pressure, Intimidating a Victim or Witness 2nd, Driving While Intoxicated, Gang Assault 2nd, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Forcible Touching, Probation Warrant, Forgery 2nd and Menacing 2nd. Officers arrested twenty-seven people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 57% of the arrests for the week.
