Part One Crime = 23

Part One crime during the week of May 11th through May 17th, 2015 experienced an increase compared to the previous week. Violent Crime experienced an increase this week of one additional incident. While Robbery decreased, Aggravated Assault increased. There were no domestic assaults. There were two gun related assaults, but no bullet to body shootings. Both Robbery and Aggravated Assault are showing decreases so far this month. Total Property Crime figures showed no change this week. Residential Burglaries increased while Larcenies decreased by the same amount. Two of the three Residential Burglaries for the week showed unlocked doors.

Calls for Service = 743

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 743 total calls for service during the week. This was an increase of a little over 2% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 16% of the call activity for the week. This was a 60% increase over the previous week and is generally an officer initiated activity. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 15% of entries. This call type experienced a 14% reduction over the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service experienced a decrease over the previous week. "Gun Call" showed a significant increase over the previous week, but this was offset by reductions in both "Shooting" and "Shots Fired" calls.

Arrests = 51

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 51 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2nd, Obstruction of Breathing, Aggravated Criminal Contempt, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Leaving the Scene of a Auto Accident with Injury, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Burglary 2nd and Assault 2nd. Officers arrested seventeen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 33% of the arrests for the week.
