Part One Crime = 36

Part One crime during the week of May 16th through May 22nd experienced an increase compared to the previous week. Violent Crime saw an increase after increases in both Robberies and Aggravated Assault. There were two strong-arm Robberies, as well as one gunpoint Robbery. The gunpoint Robbery has been closed in arrest. There was one Aggravated Assault that was domestic in nature this week. There were five gun related Assaults for the week. One incident had three shooting victims, but has been closed in arrest. Property Crime yielded a decrease this week compared to the previous week after reductions in both Residential Burglary and Auto Theft. Commercial Burglary and Larceny both showed increases for the week.

City of Newburgh Police administered Narcan once during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 665

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 665 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of 4% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 14% of the call activity for the week. This was a 10% increase over the previous week. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 10% of entries. This call type experienced a 9% decrease in call volume compared to the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service showed a significant increase in entries this week compared to the previous week. "Gun Call" entries showed a reduction this week, but both "Shooting" and "Shots Fired" entries showed notable increases for the week.

Written Incident Reports = 130

Arrests = 64

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 64 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Discharge of a Gun within City Limits, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5th, Petit Larceny, Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, Burglary 2nd, Grand Larceny 3rd, Robbery 2nd, Attempted Assault 2nd, Obstructing Governmental Administration 2nd and Criminal Contempt 2nd. Officers arrested eighteen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 28% of the arrests for the week.
