Part One Crime = 23

Part One crime during the week of May 25th through May 31st, 2015 showed a minor decrease compared to the previous week. Violent Crime experienced no change for the week. Robbery yielded a significant increase and included one Robbery that was domestic in nature. Aggravated Assaults showed a reduction. There were two assaults that were domestic in nature. There were two gun related assaults including one shooting and one arrest. Total Property Crime levels showed a reduction this week. There were increases in both Residential Burglary and Commercial Burglary, but the decrease in Larceny was enough to offset the other increases.

Calls for Service = 704

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 704 total calls for service during the week. This was an increase of nearly 5% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Disorderly Person" with 17% of the call activity for the week. This call type includes both adults and juveniles. This was a 16% increase over the last week. "Traffic Complaint" was the next most frequent call type with 11% of entries. This call type showed a 15% reduction over the previous week.

Arrests = 63

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 63 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Criminal Mischief, Menacing 2nd, Resisting Arrest, Assault 2nd, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Attempted Robbery 1st, Violation of Probation, Attempted Assault 1st, Tampering with Physical Evidence and Obstruction of Breathing. Officers arrested nineteen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 30% of the arrests for the week.
