Part One Crime = 37

Part One crime during the week of June 27th through July 3rd experienced an increase compared to the previous week. Violent Crime showed no change in total figures, but Aggravated Assaults showed an increase. There were two Aggravated Assaults that was domestic in nature this week. There were three gun related Assaults and all three were shootings. Property Crime yielded an increase this week compared to the previous week. Larcenies showed a slight increase. The City has been experiencing an increase in thefts from cars.

City of Newburgh Police administered Narcan once during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 622

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 622 total calls for service during the week. This was an increase of 2.5% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Disorderly Person" with 12% of the call activity for the week. This was a decrease of 6% over the previous week. "Traffic Complaint" was the next most frequent call type with 10% of entries. This call type experienced a 91% increase in call volume compared to the previous week.

Arrests = 59

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 59 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges Criminal Trespass 3rd, Aggravated Harassment 2nd, Burglary 3rd, Assault 2nd, Criminal Mischief 3rd, Violation of Probation, Petit Larceny and Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated. Officers arrested nineteen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 32% of the arrests for the week.
