Part One Crime = 26

Part One crime during the week of July 20th through July 26th, 2015 showed no change in total crime volume compared to the previous week. Violent Crime yielded a reduction. Despite the reduction, Aggravated Assaults remained high. There was one domestic assault. There were four gun related assaults during the week with two bullet to body shootings. There have been arrests and firearms recovered so far in these cases. Property Crime experienced an increase this week compared to the previous week. There was an additional Commercial Burglary and Auto Theft this week. The Commercial Burglary was quickly closed through the arrest of multiple juveniles.

City of Newburgh Police did not administer Narcan during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 706

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 706 total calls for service during the week. This was a reduction of approximately 12% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Disorderly Person" with 13% of the call activity for the week. This was a decrease of nearly 19% over last week's volume for this call entry. "Traffic Compliant" was the next most frequent call type with 12% of entries. This call type showed a 25% decrease over the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service experienced a 50% reduction this week compared to the previous week. The most notable decrease was sustained by "Gun Call" entries with a decrease of 80%. "Shots Fired" entries also showed a reduction.

Written Incident Reports = 103

Arrests = 64

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 64 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Petit Larceny, Driving While Intoxicated, Menacing 2nd, Obstruction of Breathing, Criminal Possession of a Firearm, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property, Patronizing a Prostitute, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Cruelty to Animals, Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance 3rd and Assault 2nd . Officers arrested twenty-one people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 33% of the arrests for the week.
