Part One Crime = 31

Part One crime during the week of July 4th through July 10th showed a reduction compared to the previous week. Violent Crime showed no change in total figures, but Robbery experienced an increase. There was one Aggravated Assaults that was domestic in nature this week. There were three gun related Assaults, but no shootings. One incident involved alcohol and all three have been closed in arrest. Property Crime showed a reduction this week compared to the previous week. The reduction was driven by a significant decrease in Larcenies. Residential Burglaries, however, sustained an increase during the week.

City of Newburgh Police administered Narcan once during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 600

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 600 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of 3.5% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Disorderly Person" with 14% of the call activity for the week. This was an increase of 9% over the previous week. "Traffic Complaint" was the next most frequent call type with 7% of entries. This call type experienced a 34% decrease in call volume compared to the previous week.

Arrests = 45

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 45 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges Reckless Endangerment 1st, Burglary 1st, Menacing 2nd, Criminal Contempt 2nd, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Obstruction of Breathing, Probation Warrant, Violation of Probation, Criminal Mischief 4th, Driving While Intoxicated and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. Officers arrested sixteen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 36% of the arrests for the week.
