Part One Crime = 27

Part One crime during the week of August 15th through August 21st experienced a decrease compared to the previous week. Violent Crime showed a decrease driven by reductions in Aggravated Assault. There was one Aggravated Assault that was domestic in nature this week and it has been closed in arrest. There were no gun related Assaults this week. Property Crime yielded a decrease this week compared to the previous week. Three of the four Property Crime subcategories experienced reductions this week. Auto Theft was the only one to show a weekly increase.

City of Newburgh Police administered Narcan twice during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 625

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 625 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of approximately 4% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 16% of the call activity for the week. This was a slight increase over the previous week. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 11% of entries. This volume of entries for this call type was exactly the same as last week's volume.

Arrests = 55

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 55 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Assault 2nd, Probation Warrants, Leaving the Scene of an Auto Accident (Injury), Criminal Mischief 3rd, Criminal Contempt 2nd, Vehicular Assault 2nd, Obstruction of Breathing, Menacing 2nd, Public Lewdness, Fugitive from Justice, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Burglary 2nd and Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd. Officers arrested fifteen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 27% of the arrests for the week.
