### Part One Crime = 19

Part One crime during the week of August 17th through August 23th, 2015 experienced a reduction compared to the previous week. Violent Crime yielded a decrease of one incident for the week. Aggravated Assaults saw a significant reduction for the week, but Robberies increased. Robberies predominately occurred on a street level with suspects targeting cash and cell phones. There were no domestic Aggravated Assaults this week. There were two bullet to body shootings during the week. Property Crime experienced a reduction this week compared to the previous week. This decrease was driven most notably by a reduction in Larcenies.

*City of Newburgh Police did not administer Narcan during the reporting period.*

### Calls for Service = 691

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 691 total calls for service during the week. This was a 10% increase compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 21% of the call activity for the week. This was an increase of 81% over last week's volume for this call entry.

"Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 12% of entries. This call type showed a similar volume as the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service experienced a reduction of two calls this week compared to the previous week. "Shots Fired" entries experienced an increase with "Shooting" entries remaining unchanged. "Weapon Violation" and "Gun Call" entries showed reductions compared to the previous week.

### Written Incident Reports = 117

### Arrests = 64

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 64 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Harassment 2nd, Driving While Intoxicated, Unlawful Fleeing a Police Officer in a Motor Vehicle, Petit Larceny, Obstructing Governmental Administration, Criminal Mischief, Assault 2nd, Obstruction of Breathing or Blood Circulation, Resisting Arrest, Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance 5th and Trespass. Officers arrested twenty people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 31% of the arrests for the week.
