Part One Crime = 31

Part One crime during the week of August 24th through August 30th, 2015 experienced a significant increase compared to the previous week. Both Violent Crime and Property Crime yielded increases this week. Robbery showed three additional incidents for the week and included the gunpoint bank Robbery on August 24th. The majority of the other Robberies for the week occurred on a street level. Aggravated Assaults experienced a slight increase for the week. There was one domestic Aggravated Assaults this week that has already been closed with an arrest. There was one bullet to body shooting during the week. Property Crime experienced an increase with week due to a sudden jump in Larcenies. Six of the fifteen Larcenies were Thefts from Motor Vehicles. Some incidents did show unsecured vehicles, but the majority showed forced entry to obtain valuables in plain sight.

City of Newburgh Police did not administered Narcan during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 685

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 685 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of almost 1% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 21% of the call activity for the week. This volume was very similar to last week's levels. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 12% of entries. This call type also showed a similar volume as the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service experienced a significant reduction compared to the previous week (-80%). "Gun Call" and "Weapons Violation" entries continue to show no activity, while "Shooting" and "Shots Fired" calls yielded reductions.

Written Incident Reports = 110

Arrests = 63

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 63 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Assault 2nd, Grand Larceny 4th, Menacing 2nd, Obstruction of Governmental Administration, Petit Larceny, Resisting Arrest, Aggravated Harassment 2nd, Cruelty to Animals, Robbery 1st, Robbery 3rd, Aggravated Criminal Contempt and Violation of Parole. Officers arrested twenty-one people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 33% of the arrests for the week.
