Part One Crime = 26

Part One crime during the week of August 29th through September 4th experienced an increase compared to the previous week. Violent Crime showed an increase after a Homicide and two additional Aggravated Assaults. There was one Aggravated Assault that was domestic in nature this week. There were two gun related Assaults this week with one resulting in a bullet to body shooting. The Homicide also involved a firearm. Property Crime showed an increase this week compared to the previous week. Both Larceny and Auto Theft experienced increases for the week.

City of Newburgh Police did not administer Narcan during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 662

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 662 total calls for service during the week. This was an increase of nearly 10% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 12% of the call activity for the week. This was an increase of approximately 7% over the previous week. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 11% of entries. This call type experienced an increase of 12% this week compared to last week.

Weapon related calls for service experienced an increase this week compared to the previous week. "Shooting" entries showed no change this week compared to last week, but both "Gun Call" and "Shots Fired" entries showed increases for the week.

Written Incident Reports = 129

Arrests = 72

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 72 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Exposure of a Person, Driving While Intoxicated, Harassment 2nd, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Burglary 2nd, Menacing 2nd, Cruelty to Animals, Violation of Parole, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Criminal Mischief 3rd, Resisting Arrest, Burglary 3rd, Obstruction of Governmental Administration and Criminal Trespass. Officers arrested thirty people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 42% of the arrests for the week.
