Part One Crime = 21

Part One crime during the week of August 31st through September 6th, 2015 yielded a decrease compared to the previous week. Both Violent Crime and Property Crime saw decreases for the week. Both Robbery and Aggravated Assault experienced reductions of three incidents each. There were no domestic Aggravated Assaults this week. There were also no bullet to body shootings during the week. Property Crime experienced an increase after a reduction in Larcenies. Residential Burglaries are showing an increase this week after a few burglaries into sheds and garages.

City of Newburgh Police administered Narcan once during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 672

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 672 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of almost 2% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 20% of the call activity for the week. This volume was a very slight decrease over last week's levels. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 11% of entries. This call type also showed a similar volume as the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service experienced a dramatic increase compared to the previous week (200%). "Shots Fired" calls had the highest volume for the week and showed an increase compared to the previous week. Both "Gun Call" and "Shooting" entries showed increases as well.

Written Incident Reports = 104

Arrests = 53

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 53 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Reckless Driving, Criminal Mischief, Robbery 2nd, Violation of Parole (two different subjects), Criminal Possession of Stolen Property, Obstruction of Governmental Administration, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Driving While Intoxicated and Harassment 2nd. Officers arrested twenty people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 38% of the arrests for the week.
