Part One Crime = 31

Part One crime during the week of August 8th through August 14th showed an increase compared to the previous week. Violent Crime experienced an increase despite reductions in Homicide and Rape. There were two Robberies this week which were both strong-arm. There was one Aggravated Assault that was domestic in nature this week and has been closed in arrest. There were no gun related Assault this week. Property Crime showed an increase this week compared to the previous week. Both Commercial Burglary and Larceny showed increases with Larceny having the greatest impact on the Property Crime totals.

City of Newburgh Police administered Narcan once during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 653

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 653 total calls for service during the week. This was an increase of 14% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Traffic Complaint" with 15% of the call activity for the week. This was an increase of 146% over the previous week. "Disorderly Person" was the next most frequent call type with 11% of entries. This was an increase of 30% compared to the previous week.

Arrests = 66

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 66 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Menacing 3rd, Burglary 3rd, Harassment 2nd, Driving While Intoxicated, Peddling Without a License, Trespass, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd, Petit Larceny, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2nd, Reckless Endangerment 1st, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property, Criminal Use of a Firearm 2nd, Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance 3rd, Violation of Parole, Endangering the Welfare of a Child and Robbery 2nd. Officers arrested twenty-two people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 33% of the arrests for the week.
