Part One Crime = 31

Part One crime during the week of August 11th through August 17th experienced an increase of 29% compared to the previous week. Both Violent Crime and Property Crime increased by 29% each. Robbery and Aggravated Assault both yielded increases for the week. There are two additional incidents under investigation that could also be categorized as Aggravated Assaults based on investigation outcomes. This week's assaults included one domestic related incident and three gun related incidents. There were two bullet to body shootings as well. Property Crime saw increases in both Burglary types along with Larcenies. Several of the Larcenies were thefts from unlocked cars.

Calls for Service = 555

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 555 total calls for service during the week. This is a 13% reduction over the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Disorderly Person," which showed a 23% reduction compared to last week. This call type accounted for 11% of the week's activity. "Traffic Complaint" was the next most frequent call type and it yielded a 16% decrease compared to last week.

Total weapons related calls for service volume was the same as last week. "Shots Fired" was the most frequent call type for the week and increased by 100%. "Gun Call" had the highest volume last week, but decreased by 56% this week.

Arrests = 52

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 52 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Fugitive from Justice, Menacing 2nd, Violation of Parole, Burglary 3rd, Assault 2nd and Assault 1st. Officers arrested fourteen people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 27% of the arrests for the week.
