MONTHLY REPORT

FEBRUARY 2012

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE (1365):

- Monthly Routine Maintenance includes collection from various City Owned Properties:
- 141 Properties to maintain City Wide in addition to Culverts, Parking Lots, Bridges, Parks and all Municipal Building sidewalks.

MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS (1610):

- Maintenance for this division for this month included over 60 calls regarding Climate Control. Routine maintenance such as replenishing paper and product supplies and cleaning of all buildings including: Police Dept., Fire Dept, City Hall, Recreation, 123 Grand St., DPW, and City Courts.

TRAFFIC (3310):

- Put traffic lights back in sequence at Broadway & 9w to 9w & Dickson St numerous times.
- Checked traffic lights City Wide numerous times.
- Cleaned Traffic trucks weekly.
- Collected coins from Parking Meters
- Put lights back in sequence at Broadway & Grand and Broadway and Liberty
- Rebuilt 14 Parking meters.
- Reset numerous traffic controllers due to poor weather conditions.
- Repaired 27 street lights on Marine Drive.
- Changed 16 bulbs in traffic lights City-wide
- Replaced 7 parking meters on Broadway
- Re-built numerous street lights in shop for future use.
- Made 6 new signs
- Replaced 25+ street signs City Wide.
- Plowed City Streets & Sidewalks during snow event.
- Changed numerous bulbs in City Hall & ballasts.
- Changed numerous bulbs in the Courthouse.
- Removed all signs & stickers from traffic cabinets City Wide.
- Installed new data & phone lines in DPW garage.
- Fixed Parking lot lights at Police Dept.
- Removed old backstop from the Recreation ballfield
- Installed new receptacles & wiremold in the Mayor's Office.
- Cleaned and Organized shop to accommodate more supplies and fixture heads, (2x's)
- Fixed numerous lights & receptacles in DPW Garage and Impound Lot.

SANITARY SEWERS (8120):

- Total of 3 calls of Sewer Backups for the month of February
- The Division performed approximately 80 Markouts for Central Hudson, Water Dept. and Private Contractors..
- Approx 20 Basins cleaned due to cold weather, the machine can not operate correctly and freezes.
- Every Friday, routine maintenance is performed in 20 Mains and Manholes (problem areas), to ensure unnecessary buildup of grease, toilet paper, etc....
- 6 Sewer Pump Stations are maintained

SANITATION (8160):

For the month of February, Sanitation Division collected 706.75 tons of garbage and 68.17 tons of recycling.
