Paper Mills: Walsh & Son
Cotton Factories: Walsh, Burns
Hat Factories: Barker
Pin Factories: Starret & Witherell
Hair Cloth Factories: Starret & Witherall

n.b. Dubois' mill two miles SW of village was formerly Hasbrouck's (built 1753) then Van Keuren's (to about 1800)
