## MONTHLY REPORT

### OCTOBER 2012

#### PROPERTY MAINTENANCE (1365):

- Monthly Routine Maintenance includes collection of garbage from various City Owned Properties. The following items were picked up City Wide:
- Over 200 Properties to maintain City Wide in addition to Culverts, Parking Lots, Bridges, Parks and all Municipal Building sidewalks.

#### MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS (1610):

- Routine cleaning and maintenance of City Hall and Police Department Daily.\
- Maintenance for this division for this month included: Approximately 15 calls regarding Air Conditioning not working..
- Routine maintenance such as replenishing paper and product supplies and cleaning of all buildings including: Police Dept., City Hall, 104 S. Lander St., Recreation, 123 Grand St., DPW, and City Courts.

#### TRAFFIC (3310):

- Put lights back in sequence from Broadway & 9W to 9W & Dickson St.
- Checked traffic lights, signs, and traffic cabinets City-Wide (weekly)
- Cleaned Traffic trucks weekly.
- Collected Parking Meters
- Repaired 53 Parking Meters.
- Reset numerous traffic controllers City-Wide due to poor weather conditions
- Repaired street lights at Front Street & Marine Dr.
- Replaced 84 streets signs City-wide
- Removed stickers & signs from Traffic Poles, and Cabinets
- Cleaned City Buildings
- Painting Football Field on 9W weekly
- Repaired 24 Bulbs in Traffic Lights, City Wide.
- Repaired electrical issues in DPW Building, Courthouse, and City Hall, Recreation, and Police Department.
- Replaced Flashing light at Little Britain Rd., and Wisner Ave.
- Finished with the new installation of Air Conditioners at Police Dept.
- Met with D.O.T about all intersections on South Street numerous times.
- Replaced new lighting to the City Hall Parking Lot
- Painted Lake St. & Washington Crosswalks
- Repaired the short in the traffic light wires at 9W & Dickson
- Continued clean up after Hurricane Sandy
- Repaired faulty wiring at Fullerton & South Street.
- Cleaned gutters at K-9
- Made banner for Independent Living
- Fixed all lights at Unico Park
- Repaired receptacles for Christmas Tree at Unico Park



**GARAGE/MECHANICS (5132):**

Division repaired approximately 85 various department vehicles and equipment such as: routine maintenance Breakdowns, and write ups.

**POLICE GARAGE (5133) :**

- 20 Hazardous Impounds were towed this month
- Approximately 55 Police vehicles were repaired such as: routine maintenance, tires, breakdowns and write ups.

**PARKS (7110):**

- Daily field maintenance at The Recreation Park
- Maintenance of all Parks City Wide including: Downing Park and The Recreation Park.

**SANITARY SEWERS (8120):**

- Total of 5 calls of Sewer Backups for the month of September.
- The Division performed approximately 200 Markouts for Central Hudson, Water Dept. and Private Contractors.
- Approx 15 Basins were cleaned.
- 6 Sewer Pump Stations are maintained

**SANITATION (8160):**

For the month of October, Sanitation Division collected 824.07 tons of garbage and 73.58 tons of recycling.
