A site plan application must include sufficient plans and descriptive information. Site plans must be prepared by a licensed professional engineer, architect, or landscape architect as permitted by the New York State Law, and must include at a minimum, information from the following checklist:

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS: All of the Following are REQUIRED on ALL Site Plans.

 - -Uses intended for structure (give estimated structure area for each use)
 - -Estimated number of employees
 - -Maximum seating capacity
 - -Number of parking spaces existing and required for use



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- o Elevations (scale: 1/4 inch = 1 ft) & design features of proposed/altered/expanded exterior façades
- o Soil logs/percolation test results/stormwater runoff calculations (if requested)
- o Disposition plans for construction/demo water

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- o Cultural resource survey (if appropriate)
- o Complete proposed development (if applicant wished to develop in stages)
- o Hazardous materials associated with proposed industrial use
- o Use, storage, treatment & disposal of hazardous materials
- o Viewshed analyses (only for WG, PWD, and part of DN Districts, as well as additional locations the Planning Board identifies during site plan review process)
