SUMMARY OF THE CONSOLIDATED PLAN

The Consolidated Plan for the City of Newburgh has been prepared in response to a consolidated process developed by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) program. The City participates in the CDBG program and is required to prepare and submit a consolidated plan for HUD approval in order to receive Community Development Grant Funds.

In the Consolidated Plan, Newburgh has: 1) described its housing needs and market conditions; 2) prepared a housing and homeless needs assessment; 3) set out a five year non-community development plan that establishes priorities for meeting those needs; 4) established a one-year action plan that outlines the intended use of resources; and, 5) identified resources anticipated to be available.

Federal regulations require that this summary be published in one or more local, general circulation newspapers. This summary describes the purpose and priorities of the plan, type and location of activities and the location of the complete document. Copies of the Consolidated Plan and the Annual Action Plan will be available for public review and comment between October 7 and November 7, 2014, at the Department of Planning & Development, Clerks Office, the Newburgh Free Library, and on the City website at www.cityofnewburgh-ny.gov/community-development. ACTION PLAN

The Annual Action Plan sets forth a description of activities for the use of funds that are expected to become available during the coming Federal fiscal year, determines goals for individuals and households to be served, and describes the implementation plan and geographic location of the activities to be undertaken. The formula allocation for the Community Development Block Grant program is \$787,179. Program Income totals \$82,000.
