## **EPA LEAD PAINT REGULATION FOR ALL CONTRACTORS AND RENOVATORS/REMODELERS**

**Attention Contractors and Home Renovators**

**New EPA guidelines require you to be trained and re-certified.**

**\*\* AVOID FINES OF UP TO \$37,500 for each violation**

### **Lead Remodeler and Renovator – Course Dates in Orange County**

**RRP English – March 19<sup>th</sup> (8am – 4pm)**

**RRP Spanish – February 27<sup>th</sup> (8am – 4pm)**

The EPA has ruled that contractors who perform renovation, repairs, and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child-care facilities, and schools built before 1978 must be certified and follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination. EPA requires that firms performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in pre-1978 homes, child care facilities and schools must be certified by EPA and use certified renovators who are trained to follow lead safe work practices.

Contractors can become certified renovators through an 8-hour training course at the Orange County Department of Health provided by Big Apple Occupational Safety Corp. ([www.baos.com](http://www.baos.com)).

Certification is required for all home improvement activity that disturbs more than 6 square feet of interior or 20 square feet of exterior lead paint in housing built before 1978 and child-occupied facilities.
