Part One Crime = 30

Part One crime during the week of June 15th through June 21st, 2015 showed an increase compared to the previous week. Violent Crime yielded an increase after three of the four subcategories increased. There was one domestic assault and one bullet to body shooting during the week. Property Crime also increased this week compared to the previous week. This was driven by increases in Residential Burglary and Larceny. One subject has been arrested thus far for one of the week's Residential Burglaries. There were multiple thefts from cars in the Larceny category with some cars showing their doors were left unlocked.

City of Newburgh Police administered Narcan in two incidents during the reporting period.

Calls for Service = 672

The City of Newburgh Police Department logged 672 total calls for service during the week. This was a decrease of 8% compared to the previous week. The most frequent call for service type for the week was "Disorderly Person" with 16% of the call activity for the week. This call type includes both juveniles and adults. "Traffic Complaint" was the next most frequent call type with 9% of entries. This call type showed a 57% reduction over the previous week.

Weapon related calls for service showed no change in total numbers between this week and the previous week. Increases occurred in both "Gun Call" entries and "Shooting" entries. "Shots Fired" calls experienced a decrease of 50% over the previous week.

Arrests = 50

Officers and detectives effected multiple arrests during the week to yield a total of 50 individuals arrested in the City. Notable arrests included charges for Strangulation 2nd, Attempted Assault 2nd, Exposure of a Person, Assault 2nd, Burglary 2nd and Driving While Intoxicated. Officers arrested eleven people who were not residents of the City of Newburgh. These arrests accounted for 22% of the arrests for the week.
